All hats and medical armbands MUST be taken to the secretary to be checked when you collect your number. A £5.00 cash deposit is required for a cross country bib on the day.

Cheques to be made payable to Woodland Hunt Pony Club. Entries close Saturday 19th June – please call the secretary re late entries. **Places are strictly limited.**

Individual rosettes will be awarded to 8th place, and team rosettes to 3rd. A special rosette will be awarded to best dressage that completes the course. Cups will be presented to the highest placed Woodland members.

Please note the Dressage is 20 mins walk from the lorry park; make sure you have all your equipment!

Course Walking- the course may be walked on Saturday 26th June between 14.00 and 18.00. All dogs must be kept on a lead - no extendable leads allowed at any time.

General rules and conditions

1. The horse trials will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing rules 2010.
2. Entries will be limited and will be on a first come first served basis. No rider may enter more than 2 horses. No entry fee will be refunded without the production of a doctor's or vet's certificate, presented within 2 weeks of the event date, when a £5.00 fee will be retained for administration.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without stating the reason and to alter the programme if the weather conditions so require. In the event of cancellation of the event the entry fee, less fixed costs will be refunded upon the receipt of a SAE before July 10th 2010
4. Competitors eliminated from the show jumping will be permitted to ride the cross country course at the SJ Steward's discretion.
5. The judge's / steward's decision is final.
6. All riders must wear hats that conform to the 2010 Pony club hat rules. No fixed peak hats to be worn on the Cross Country phase in any class.
7. Body protectors and medical armbands must be worn for the cross country phase. Stop watches may not be worn.
8. Legal liability. Save for death and personal injury caused by negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom in law, they are responsible, neither the organisers of the event, nor the pony club, or any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for the accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horse, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents, or any other property or person whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
9. Health and safety. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of every one present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey all the rules and the instructions of the organisers, stewards and officials.
10. Objections. The judge's decision is final. Objections to be lodged at the secretary's tent in writing within 30 minutes together with a deposit of £20.00.
11. Entry signifies acceptance of the above rules.
12. Copies of the Pony club test may be purchased from www.pcuk.org
13. If a rider chooses to wear an air vest it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall, it must be fully deflated or removed before continuing. Competitors wearing air vests must provide their own elasticated number bib.
14. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times – absolutely no extendable leads allowed. No dogs will be allowed on the cross country course on the competition day.
